

HPPR Pets for Vets Program

- The HPPR Pets for Vets Program recognizes and honors the service of men and women in the US Armed Forces.
- HPPR will subsidize up to \$100 per family which includes one or more US Veterans to be applied to the adoption fee of a pet for whom there is an **approved application**.
- Normal adoption fees apply, less the \$100 subsidy.
- If the adoption fee is less than the credit, the balance may be applied to the adoption fee of another pet. If another pet is not adopted, the remaining balance is forfeited.
- Spay / Neuter deposits are **NOT** included in the subsidy amount.
- Veteran agrees to allow a photo of him/herself with the pet, and will share a short story for our newsletter.
- A US veteran who wishes to adopt will need to provide the following forms of military identification: **DD-214 or Veteran's ID**.
- While HPPR would like to offer this program as a continuous policy, we rely on adoption fees to finance our efforts to help animals in need throughout our community and can only offer it when our financial strength permits.
- Most of our rescued pets will be available for adoption through this program, but some limitations apply.
- All other terms and conditions in the adoption policies set forth by HPPR apply to the Pets for Vets Program
